# A Year of Pivoting with a Purpose

Looking back on the 2020 program year brings a variety of feelings: pride, affirmation, and, in truth, a bit of exhaustion. No one knew what unprecedented times lay ahead when we began 2020. That said, we can honestly say that we closed a year like no other with a true sense of accomplishment and gratitude for all who supported us during unforeseeable times.

We titled our letter this year 'pivoting with a purpose' because that was the theme of our leadership, board, and clinical decision-making throughout 2020. Despite the pandemic, we didn't close our doors because we knew we simply couldn't. In partnership with our medical peers, we delivered emergency care only for the first 12 weeks of the pandemic, ensuring that dental emergencies did not end up in our already taxed hospitals. We pivoted to this new model, while concurrently piloting new safety protocols, expanding personal protective equipment, and leveraging staff members to keep our team actively employed.

By June we resumed regular treatment at our Waukesha clinic and were fully operational, with all team members back in their regular roles, by July 1. Our board took on significant and rapid decision-making relative to our finances, operations, and human resources. Thanks to their dedication and leadership, we are proud to say that our clinics stayed safely open, our team remained intact, and most importantly, our patients received the dental care they needed in 2020.

This achievement would not have been possible without the significant financial support we received from our donors in 2020. In a normal year, roughly 60% of our budget comes from contributed revenue and in 2020 that became increasingly pronounced, as we were limited in earned revenue due to shifting clinical care.

Within this year's report, we rightfully celebrate the heroes on our team, the partners who help make our work a success, and the donors who invest in bringing this mission to life. Thank you for all you do for our patients!

## 2020

### JANUARY

New program year launched  
Continued patient growth at new Menomonee Falls clinic

### MARCH

A new emergency care model is launched within one week of the Safer at Home Order.

### MARCH-MAY

Emergency care only is delivered from our Waukesha clinic for residents throughout Southeastern Wisconsin.

- 186 emergency appointments
- 103 low-income individuals served (69% new patients)

Safety and operational protocols are developed with direction from dental and medical leaders throughout the nation.

All CSD staff are returned to regular employment status after a brief period of furlough for some team members.

### JUNE

CSD reopens the Waukesha clinic for comprehensive care. New clinical and safety operations are piloted for all staff.

### JULY

Both CSD clinics fully resume operations.

All staff return to in-person work.

### SEPTEMBER

Patient demand surpasses pre-COVID volumes.

The Adult Dental Program is expanded in Menomonee Falls to meet growing demand.

### NOVEMBER

Increasing patient demand continues due to:

- increased awareness about our programs
- more income-qualifying families
- limited public dental options outside of the CSD as a result of the pandemic

# Our Rebranding Process

On January 26, 2021, we officially announced our organizational rebrand as Community Smiles Dental (formerly known as the Waukesha County Community Dental Clinic). While this exciting milestone launched our 2021 program year, the nitty gritty of the rebrand evaluation occurred during the 2020 program year.

Initial discussions began in 2019 when we determined the need to evaluate our name, brand, and marketing needs during our strategic planning process. With a newly added clinic and growing regional reach, the need for a refreshed strategic plan and an examination of our existing name became increasingly pressing.

Preliminary steps were taken in 2019 to prepare for the brand evaluation, including surveying key stakeholders to understand current brand awareness and extensively interviewing agencies who could partner with us on this project. Thanks to a generous grant from the Nonprofit Management Fund we were able to contract Ampersand for this work. Despite the challenges of 2020, we remained committed to our rebrand timeline and worked creatively to push the project forward.

The selection of Community Smiles Dental, along with our new mission, vision, core values, and logo, brought to life the important work we are doing to serve those in our community who consistently struggle with equitable access to dental care. Community is the core of who we are—we were built by community members, grown by community support, and look ahead with an unwavering commitment to serve those in our community with the greatest need.

Our new brand celebrates the growth we've experienced to date and all the growth to come, as we continue to expand our services to more families in need and into the larger region.

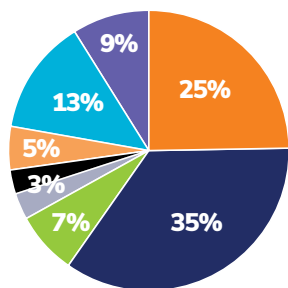
# 2020 Financial Position

We are proud of our diligent work in ensuring our continued financial health, allowing us to provide dental care to those who need it most.

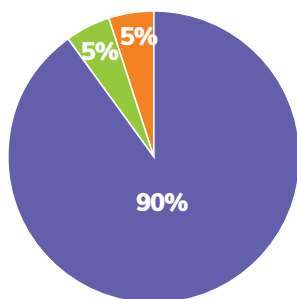

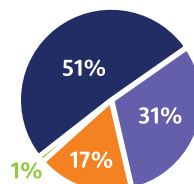
# 2020 Impact

We provided the equivalent of \$2.15 million in dental care and served 2,896 unduplicated children and 290 adults.



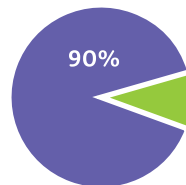
## Waukesha Clinic

100% of Waukesha clinic patients are Waukesha County Residents



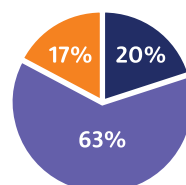
## Menomonee Falls Clinic

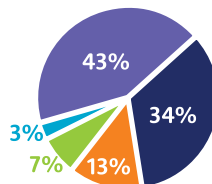
## Youth

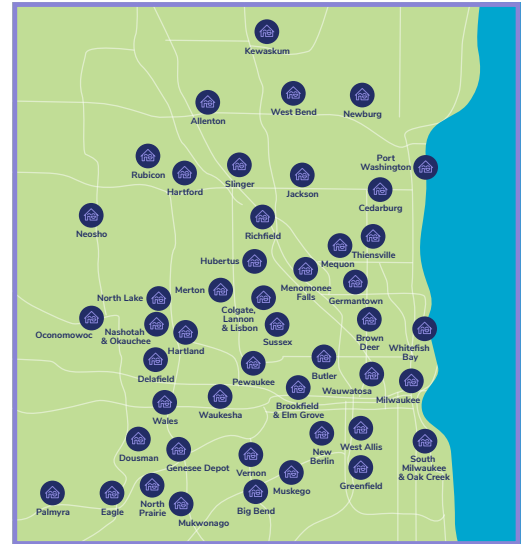

## Meet Michael



While most know Community Smiles Dental for its focus on children, serving adults and children with developmental, cognitive, and physical disabilities is a key tenet of our mission and programs.

Our Special Smiles Program is designed to address a gap in access to dental services for individuals with special health needs. Both of our clinics include a special treatment room designed to support the care needs of these patients in an inclusive, quality and compassionate setting. Our clinicians receive specific training to support the physical, emotional and sensory care of these individuals. Throughout treatment, parents, patients and/or caregivers are involved in the decision-making process regarding the dental treatment plan, home care plans, and ongoing preventative care.

One of the wonderful individuals served by this program is Michael, who was referred to us for ongoing care after aging out of Children's Hospital's pediatric program for special needs individuals. Michael has been able to receive regular treatment every three months at our clinics and would have had nowhere else to go for his dental care needs.

When talking with his mother, Joanne, she stated: "When I come here to the Community Smiles clinic with my son Michael, they don't look at him like he has Down's Syndrome. They treat him like a person and not just a special needs person. They are very respectful in the way they treat him and the way they treat me. I really appreciate that. I wish they could open it up to more people so more people could come and have the experience that we've had here, because they're just so open to special needs people. The staff is good and very helpful. They're extremely accommodating. They make you feel like you're family."

It is an honor to be the dental home for Michael and the growing number of individuals served by this program.
